



Gadianton Robbers Today? Jason Anderson

hen I read
about events in
the world today, I
can't help but think of
the Book of Mormon
and the Gadianton
robbers. Such places

as Colombia, various Latin American countries, Chechnya, Israel and Al Qaeda attacks in the United States and Madrid, plus the recent attacks in London all come to mind. The Gadiantons first appeared around 52 B.C. under the leadership of Gadianton. They began as robbers and murderers, but ultimately desired to rule the nation. Gadianton types, whose secret combinations and oaths are as old as the days of Cain, proved to be the ruin of both the Nephite and Jaredite civilizations.

Is this relevant to us today? I believe it is, and following are a few examples.

First and foremost, we've already seen two once-great civilizations in the Americas brought down by these secret combinations.

"And it came to pass that they formed a secret combination, even as they of old; which combination is most abominable and wicked above all, in the sight of God...And now I, Moroni, do not write the manner of their oaths and combinations,

for it hath been made known unto me that they are had among all people, and they are had among the Lamanites, and they have caused the destruction of this people of whom I am now speaking, and also the destruction of the people of Nephi." (Ether 3:92,94 RLDS), (Ether 8:18,20-21 LDS)

Can something like this happen in such an enlightened age and powerful country as the one in which we live? The Lord has promised it will, if we as a nation do not serve Him.

"And he had sworn in his wrath unto the Brother of Jared, that whoso should possess this land of promise, from that time henceforth and forever, should serve him, the true and only God, or they should be swept off when the fullness of his wrath should come upon them. And now we can behold the decrees of God concerning this land, that it is a land of promise, and whatsoever nation shall possess it, shall serve God, or they shall be swept off when the fullness of his wrath shall come upon them." (Ether 1:30-31 RLDS), (Ether 2:8-9 LDS)

No matter what the society or religion, if the people in it do not remain righteous and vigilant, Gadianton types will organize and eventually destroy that society. Satan will use whatever openings we give him.

Let's look at the condition of the Nephites at one of

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the times the Gadiantons flourished. Was it that much different than we see now?

"Yea, the more part of them had turned out of the way of righteousness, and did trample under their feet the commandments of God, and did turn unto their own ways, and did build up unto themselves idols of their gold and their silver." (Helaman 2:158 RLDS), (Helaman 6:31 LDS)

If we read before and after this verse, we find what started as a few wicked people spread because the righteous were asleep and had become complacent. They even participated in the acts themselves and most likely believed they were still righteous. This went on until the Gadiantons even ran the government, at which point the people were ripening for destruction. You see, God is slow to act in wrath. He is willing to allow a democratic society to harbor wickedness as long as it is not the prevailing wisdom. He knows Satan will almost always be able to flatter and persuade a few. But once that democratic society chooses wickedness, there is no more patience.

"Now it is not common that the voice of the people desireth anything contrary to that which is right; but it is common for the lesser part of the people to desire that which is not right. Therefore this shall ye observe, and make it your law to do your business by the voice of the people. And if the time comes that the voice of the people doth choose iniquity, then is the time that the

judgments of God will come upon you. Yea, then is the time he will visit you with great destruction, even as he has hitherto visited this land." (Mosiah 13:35-38 RLDS), (Mosiah 29:26-27 LDS)

It is important to realize the Gadiantons never flourished where the people were righteous. They could get no foothold and either moved on or were converted or destroyed.

Finally, if there are similarities between modern-day terrorists and Gadiantons in The Book of Mormon, we should be able to look at The Book of Mormon peoples to see the different ways they dealt with these terrorists and learn which ways work and which ways fail.

What a marvelous opportunity for us to avoid going through the trial and error process our predecessors on this land had to go through!

Before we get to what I believe is the most important part of this study, how to deal with terrorists, let's first establish there are similarities between modern-day terrorists and the Gadiantons. Here are a few examples.

They attacked the innocent, even women and children.

"Yea, for they did visit many parts of the land, and did do great destruction unto them; yea, did kill many, and did carry away others captive into the wilderness; yea, and more especially their women and their children." (Helaman 4:41 RLDS), (Helaman 11:33 LDS)

We saw this in Russia when the Chechnya terrorists took over the school and threatened to kill and did kill many children.

 They claim their hate for those they terrorize stems from "the many wrongs" done unto them.

"And I, knowing of their unconquerable spirit, having proved them in the field of battle, and knowing of their everlasting hatred towards you, because of the many wrongs which ye have done unto them, therefore if they should come down against you, they would visit you with utter destruction." (3 Nephi 2:5 RLDS), (3 Nephi 3:4 LDS)



On November 24, 2002, Osama Bin Laden asked and then answered his own question, "Why are we fighting and opposing you?" "Because you attacked us and continue to attack us." He goes on to list a number of alleged grievances including attacks on the Palestinians and attacks in various places around the globe. Then he said, "It is commanded by our religion and intellect that the oppressed have a right to return the aggression. Do not await anything from us but Jihad, resistance, and revenge. Is it in any way rational to expect that after America has attacked us for more than half a century, that we will then leave her to live in security and peace?"

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 Their true motivation is not hatred of any particular policies or any supposed wrongs done to them, but power and gain.

"And moreover, to be held in office, at the head of government, to rule and do according to their wills, that they might get gain and glory of the world; and moreover that they might the more easy commit adultery, and steal, and kill, and do according to their own wills." (Helaman 3:4 RLDS), (Helaman 7:5 LDS)

 They send peace proposals, demanding concessions from those they have been attacking.

"Therefore I write unto you desiring that ye would yield up unto this my people, your cities, your lands, and your possessions, rather than that they should visit you with the sword, and that destruction should come upon you."
(3 Nephi 2:7 RLDS), (3 Nephi 3:6 LDS)

The Palestinians are demanding land for peace from the Israelis, much like Giddianhi from Lachoneus. But Giddianhi, like the Palestinians, had no intention of delivering peace. Giddianhi's goal was the total destruction of the Nephites, as is the Palestinians' goal regarding Israel. A Hamas leader in the Gaza Strip, Dr. Mahmoud al-Zahar, wrote in a letter that the terror group views Ariel Sharon's unilateral withdrawal from the Gaza Strip as a capitulation to terror and is planning to continue its "armed struggle" against the Jewish state until "all" territories are in Palestinian hands. He said, among other things, "The withdrawal, if it is implemented, is an important achievement by the Palestinian people, its intifada and armed struggle, its determination and great sacrifice, and confirms the willingness, correctness and usefulness of employing an armed struggle and its ability to attain political objectives."

• They intend to intimidate and influence by fear.

"And behold, I swear unto you, If ye will do this, with an oath, ye shall not be destroyed; but if ye will not do this, I swear unto you, with an oath, that on the morrow month, I will command that my armies shall come down against you, And they shall not stay their hand, and shall spare not, but shall slay you, and shall let fall the sword upon you, yea, even until ye shall become extinct."
(3 Nephi 2:9-10 RLDS), (3 Nephi 3:8 LDS)



We saw the terrorists intimidate the Spaniards and influence their election by bombings three days before the elections were to be held. Also, after the recent London bombings, the terrorists said other nations like Italy and Poland would be next if they did not bring their troops home soon from Iraq.

 They believe they are not only right in their actions, but believe they have the moral upper hand.

"And behold, I am Giddianhi; and I am the governor of this the secret society of Gadianton; which society, and the works thereof, I know to be good; and they are of ancient date, and they have been handed down unto us." (3 Nephi 2:11 RLDS), (3 Nephi 3:9 LDS)

Osama bin Laden, again from his 2002 message to America, speaking of Islam in general and his cause, specifically said, "It is to this religion that we call you; ... It is the religion of Unification of God, sincerity, the best of manners, righteousness, mercy, honour, purity, and piety. It is the religion of showing kindness to others, establishing justice between them ..., defending the oppressed and the persecuted."

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• A few terrorists could defy entire armies.

"And it came to pass that it was expedient that there should be a stop put to this work of destruc-

tion; therefore they sent an army of strong men into the wilderness, and upon the mountains to search out this band of robbers, and to destroy them. But behold, it came to pass that in that same year, they were driven back even into their own lands." (Helaman 4:35-36 RLDS), (Helaman 11:28-29 LDS)

We still haven't found Bin Laden or wiped out his band hiding in the mountains between Pakistan and Afghanistan. We also have not been able to stop the terrorists from infiltrating Iraq.

 These groups are founded on secret rites, protected by sworn secrecy or death.

"And it came to pass that they all swear unto him by the God of heaven, and also by the heavens, and also by

the earth, and by their heads, that whoso should vary from the assistance which Akish desired, should lose his head. And whoso should divulge whatsoever thing Akish made known unto them, the same should lose his life. And it came to pass that thus they did agree with Akish." (Ether 3:87-88 RLDS), (Ether 8:14-15 LDS)

It is widely believed that not even all 19 hijackers knew what the whole plan was on September 11, 2001.

 A charismatic leader persuades people to follow through flattery and unethical promises of power and riches.

"For there was one Gadianton who was exceeding expert in many words, and also in his craft, to carry on the secret work of murder and of robbery; therefore he became the leader of the band of Kishkumen. Therefore he did flatter them, and also Kishkumen, that if they would place him in the judgment seat, he would grant unto those who

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belonged to his band that they should be placed in power and authority among the people; therefore Kishkumen sought to destroy Helaman." (Helaman 1:40-41 RLDS), (Helaman 2:4-5 LDS)

Gadianton tactics helped install and keep people in power like Fidel Castro in Cuba, the Sandinistas in

Nicaragua, Yassur Arafat in Palestine, Al Sadr in Iraq, and so on.

 The end goal is to overthrow the thing they hate the most, liberty.

"Yea, we see that Amalickiah, because he was a man of cunning devices, and a man of many flattering words, that he led away the hearts of many people to do wickedly; Yea, and to seek to destroy the church of God, and to destroy the foundation of liberty which God had granted unto them, or which blessing God had sent upon the face of the land, for the righteous' sake." (Alma 21:38-39 RLDS), (Alma 46:10 LDS)

Satan, by his nature, hates freedom. He has wanted to take away our freedom to choose for ourselves from the very beginning. He has placed this hatred in the hearts of all Gadianton types throughout history.

So how do we deal with these modern-day Gadiantons? I see three courses of action (there may be more) taken by the Nephites and Lamanites. We should be able to look at their example to see which actions were effective.

Appease, reason with, accept and try to get along. The Nephites tried it.

"And in the three hundred and fiftieth year, we made a treaty with the Lamanites and the robbers of Gadianton, in which we did get the lands of our inheritance divided." (Mormon 1:60 RLDS), (Mormon 2:28 LDS)

They gave up lands much like Israel is doing now, but found the ensuing peace to be only temporary.

"And it came to pass that the Lamanites did not come to battle again until ten years more had passed away." (Mormon 1:63 RLDS), (Mormon 3:1 LDS)

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This was the first battle in the last war that ultimately destroyed the Nephites. Europe tried appeasement with Hitler in 1938 with the Munich agreement, which gave part of the Czech territory and other land Germany was claiming as its own to Hitler in return for promised peace. Many in this country and around the world want to try it with the terrorists. The results of appeasement and getting along with terrorists are devastating. Fifty million people died in WWII. From the 1979 Iran hostage crisis to the 1983 Marine barracks bombings in Lebanon to the first World Trade Center bombing in 1993 to Somalia in 1993



to the bombing of the USS Cole in 2000, we basically did nothing, even retreating from Lebanon and Somalia. I believe in doing so we gave encouragement to the terrorists, which ultimately led to 3,000 dying on September 11, 2001. Gadianton types ultimately want power and the destruction of freedom. Appeasing them when they are weak only gives them time to gather strength. The Saudis are learning this the hard way. They have, for all intents and purposes, bought off the Gadianton types in their own land, and now they have even turned on the ruling family, issuing death threats and other threats against the government.

Destroy. President Bush had this to say on November 8, 2001, in a speech to the nation: "Our nation faces a threat to our freedoms, and the stakes could not be higher. We are the target of enemies who boast they want to kill: kill all Americans, kill all Jews, and kill all Christians. We've seen that type of hate before, and

the only possible response is to confront it, and to defeat it. We wage a war to save civilization itself. We did not seek it, but we will fight it and we will prevail."

"And now it came to pass that when the Lamanites found that there were robbers among them, they were exceeding sorrowful; and they did use every means in their power, to destroy them off the face of the earth." (Helaman 2:144 RLDS), (Helaman 6:20 LDS)

"And it came to pass in the thirteenth year, there began to be wars and contentions throughout all the land; for the Gadianton robbers had become so numerous, and did slay so many of the people, and did lay waste so many cities, and did spread so much death and carnage throughout the land, that it became expedient that all the people, both the Nephites, and the Lamanites, should take up arms against them; Therefore all the Lamanites, who had become converted unto the Lord, did unite with their brethren, the Nephites, and were compelled, for the safety of their lives, and their women and their children, to take up arms against those Gadianton robbers; Yea, and also to maintain their rites, and their privileges of their church, and of their worship, and their freedom, and their liberty." (3 Nephi 1:48-50 RLDS), (3 Nephi 2:11-12 LDS)

It is interesting to point out destroying the enemy appears to work only when it's done by a people who are truly righteous. In Helaman 2:144 (RLDS) (Helaman 6:20 LDS), the record goes on to say that the Lamanites grew in righteousness, and they ultimately prevailed. If we keep reading in 3 Nephi 1, we find that when their motives were right, when they were righteous and fighting for a just cause, they prevailed.

"Nevertheless, the people of Nephi did gain some advantage of the robbers, insomuch that they did drive them back out of their lands into the mountains, and into their secret places." (3 Nephi 1:55 RLDS), (3 Nephi 2:17 LDS)

However, when the people became wicked and tried the same tactics, they were not successful.

"And in the fifteenth year they did come forth again against the people of Nephi; and because of the wickedness of the people of Nephi, and their many contentions and dissensions, the Gadianton robbers did gain many advantages over them. And thus ended the fifteenth year, and thus were the people in a state of many afflictions; and the sword of destruction did hang over them, insomuch that they were about to be smitten down by it, and this because of their iniquity."

(3 Nephi 1:56-57 RLDS), (3 Nephi 2:18-19 LDS)

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"And it came to pass that the Lamanites did hunt the band of robbers of Gadianton; and they did preach the word of God among the more wicked part of them, insomuch that this band of robbers was utterly destroyed from among the Lamanites." (Helaman 2:164 RLDS), (Helaman 6:37 LDS)

I don't think any of us would disagree that this is the optimal, most preferred method. It should be attempted, but we must realize that there will always be some who will reject Jesus. As long as Satan is not bound, this option will not be 100% effective. Therefore, we can never appease, and must be willing to destroy if necessary. We have examples, in fact, of the Nephites using these dual tactics with great effect.

"And now it came to pass that when they had taken all the robbers prisoners, insomuch that none did escape who were not slain, they did cast their prisoners into prison, and did cause the word of God to be preached unto them; And as many as would repent of their sins and enter into a covenant that they would murder no more, were set at liberty; But as many as there were who did not enter into a covenant, and who did still continue to have those secret murders in their hearts; yea; as many as were found breathing out threatenings against their brethren, were condemned and punished according to the law. And thus they did put an end to all those wicked, and secret, and abominable combinations, in the which there was so much wickedness, and so many murders committed." (3 Nephi 2:86-89 RLDS), (3 Nephi 5:4-6 LDS)

Ultimately, the only real deliverance we have from terrorism or any enemy is repentance and humility. We are not in a fight between western society and Al Qaeda or Islam and Christianity, but between Satan and our Savior Jesus Christ. When we are repentant, humble, and obedient, we are promised victory. When we are not, we have no promise.

The ultimate cure will come when we Christians finally get dissatisfied with what is and desperately long for what could be. It will come when we step out of our comfort zones and truly live selfless, devoted, whole-hearted lives for God. We do not have the luxury of continuing to sit back and live lives that are not really much different than the world around us. This world, which lies in darkness, needs a people who will stand up in the midst of that darkness and boldly let the light of Christ pierce

and even overcome that darkness. Then, the promises of 2 Chronicles 7:14 can become a reality.

It would be wise for us to follow the admonition of Moroni, who saw first-hand the complete destruction of his people, and thought it so important as to take up some precious space in his record. He said,

"And whatsoever nation shall uphold such secret combinations, to get power and gain, until they shall spread over the nation, behold, they shall be destroyed, for the Lord will not suffer that the blood of his saints, which shall be shed by them, shall always cry unto him from the ground for vengeance upon them, and yet he avenge them not; Wherefore, O ye Gentiles, it is wisdom in God that these things should be shewn unto you, that thereby ye may repent of your sins, and suffer not that these murderous combinations shall get above you, which are built up to get power and gain, and the work, yea, even the work of destruction come upon you; Yea, even the sword of the justice of the eternal God, shall fall upon you, to your overthrow and destruction, if ye shall suffer these things to be; Wherefore the Lord commandeth you, when ye shall see these things come among you, that ye shall awake to a sense of your awful situation, because of this secret combination which shall be among you, or wo be unto it, because of the blood of them who have been slain; for they cry from the dust for vengeance upon it, and also upon those who build it up. For it cometh to pass that whoso buildeth it up, seeketh to overthrow the freedom of all lands, nations and countries; And it bringeth to pass the destruction of all people; for it is built up by the devil, who is the father of all lies; even that same liar who beguiled our first parents; Yea, even that same liar who hath caused man to commit murder from the beginning; who hath hardened the hearts of men, that they have murdered the prophets, and stoned them, and cast them out from the beginning. Wherefore I, Moroni, am commanded to write these things, that evil may be done away, and that the time may come that Satan may have no power upon the hearts of the children of men, but that they may be persuaded to do good continually, that they may come unto the fountain of all righteousness and be saved." (Ether 3:95-102 RLDS), (Ether 8:22-26 LDS)


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The 2005 Interns

While the 2005 interns were in Mexico, we had the privilege of being able to put up a fence and construct two cement pillars for a fellow saint. We were able to complete all but a small portion of the fence on Monday and went about constructing the pillars to hold the gate. The only problem we faced was the gravel we used. The gravel ranged in size from about 3½ inches to regular gravel size. When we poured the cement in the forms, we did our best to get all the bubbles and air pockets worked out of the cement. When we returned on Wednesday and removed the forms, we discovered how many pockets of air were in the pillars. It was not an appealing sight to the eye. It was finally decided that four of us should get up early Thursday morning and go back to fix the pillars. When the four of us arrived, we went straight to work without praying for God's help. Not only was this a reminder for me, but it also witnessed to Orlando. I am always amazed at how God can use problems to fill us with a greater joy.

Recent issues of The Witness have included replacement or repair of the roof on the Wish List. It had deteriorated to the point of causing significant water damage to the ceiling and walls inside the building. We did not include the estimated cost on the Wish List because proposed bids and methods of repair were so diverse. Consequently, in May we employed a structural engineer to evaluate the situation. His report stated the original roof was a light-gauge corrugated metal roof that was too light to handle the direct load of a new roof system. A technical drawing with

structural specifications was submitted by the engineer and used to request bids from several different companies. The board, after careful evaluation, chose the bid for \$18,800. The work has been completed, but now the challenge of replenishing the funds is a priority. These funds are needed for the operational needs of BMF and to finance various programs. We are asking you, as our contributors, to give prayerful consideration to help with this special project so there is no adverse effect on existing programs. Thank you, and may the Lord richly bless you in your decision to support His work.

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
